Happy and I Know It

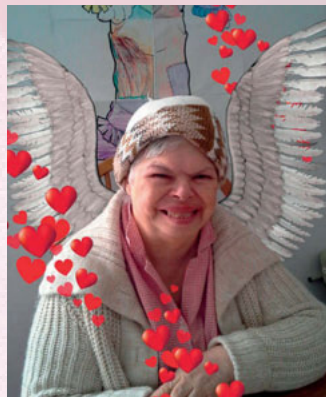
Dear Happy,

WHAT IS THE OPEN DOOR FOUNDERS' FUND?

The Open Door Founders' Fund was launched with the Virginia Squier Memorial Fund and the sale of stock that was gifted by Porter Jarvis. This fund was established with the (DDCF) DeKalb County Community Foundation in 1997.

The DCCF represents a collection of individual funds and resources contributed for endowment purposes and was established in 1993 through the creative generosity of a local DeKalb family. They provided a substantial initial funding of the Foundation to benefit charitable efforts of not-for-profit organizations in DeKalb County.

What is an endowment fund?

A fund you agree to invest forever, leaving the principal untouched and spending only the principal's earnings (or a portion of the earnings).

Why did we determine an endowment fund is a good thing?

It is a fiscally responsible approach to good financial planning that ensures that Open Door will be around in the future to carry out its mission. We need to provide support to adults with developmental disabilities, not just now, but forever. The Open Door Founders' Fund will fulfill its mission in the present and the future.

Why was DeKalb County Community Fund chosen to manage Open Door's fund?

The Open Door board of directors chose DCCF because of the affordable professional management provided by pooling resources with other funds under the community foundation umbrella.

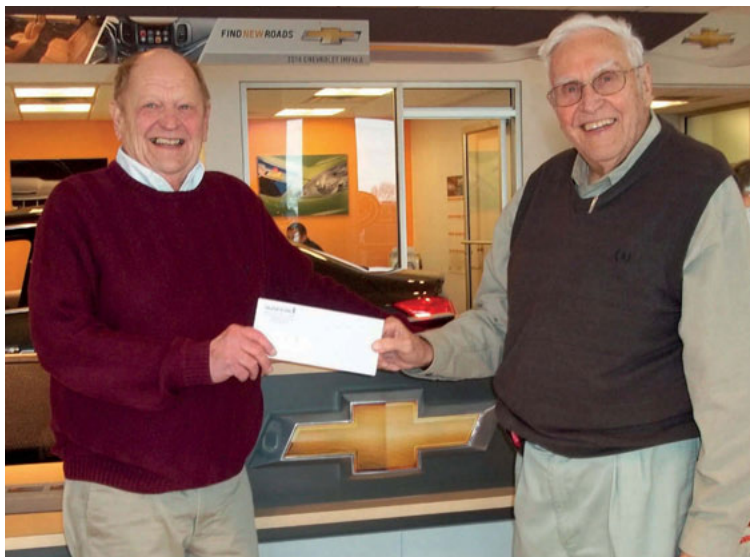
\$15,487.48 AND STILL GROWING!
